*We will remember them.*

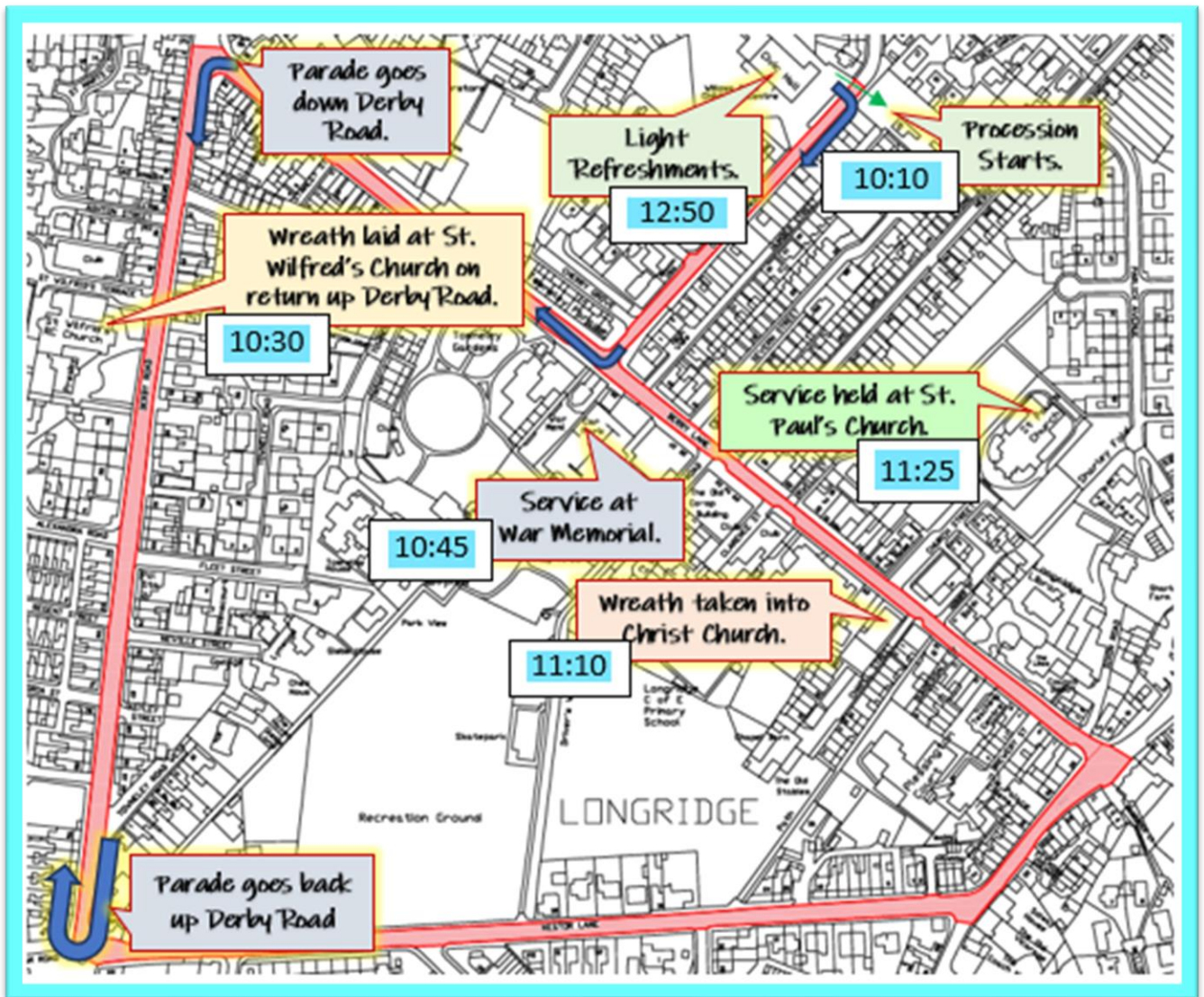


## 2. Sunday 10 November - Procession and Service.

Time	Activity
10:10am	Band starts procession from Longridge Civic Hall.
10:30am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Procession arrives at St Wilfrid's Church.</li><li>• Wreath laid by the Mayor, band will stay in place.</li><li>• Parade Marshall (PM) invites the Mayor to fall out.</li></ul>
10:45am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Procession arrives at the Memorial Garden, Berry Lane.</li><li>• Parade falls out upon the instruction of the PM</li><li>• Readings will be completed by the Vicar and Member of the Legion.</li></ul>
11:00am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Last Post is sounded and two minutes silence held.</li><li>• Wreaths will be laid.</li></ul>
11:10 - 11:20am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Member of Legion announce the procession will make way to Christ Church.</li><li>• PM and band make their way to Christ Church steps and parade stops.</li><li>• Vicar greets procession and Mayor takes wreath into church.</li><li>• Civic Party are instructed to fall out to the left.</li></ul>
11:25am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The procession moves to St. Paul's Church and stops.</li><li>• Fall out is given and procession proceeds into St Paul's for church service.</li><li>• The band usually play one of the Hymns and also a piece during the collection or interval.</li></ul>
12:30pm	Church Service ends.
12:35pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• PM reassembles the band and procession and return to the Civic Hall.</li><li>• The procession will proceed towards Willows Park Lane.</li></ul>
12:45pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mayor thanks everyone for attending band plays the National Anthem.</li><li>• Civic Party fall out and the band and parade will be dismissed by the PM</li></ul>
12:50pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Light refreshments will be provided at Longridge Civic Hall.</li></ul>
