6. CCTV.

The Clerk confirmed that all the RVBC CCTV cameras were operational, as were those operated and owned by the Town Council.

Request the Clerk to contact RVBC to see if a live stream is available to Longridge Police Station, if members can visit the operational room at RVBC, if the system can be extended to more locations, and if there any statistics on the number of requests made by the Police to access CCTV footage.

Post meeting note, update from RVBC received 24/06/2025:

The police currently have remote feed access via the Clitheroe CCTV monitoring office for all of our system (including Longridge and Whalley) RVBC have never been against this, in my experience the Police have usually just been wary of their own data protection rules and who would be able to access the footage.

Any feed setup at Longridge station is in the Police's hands. As you will be aware Police staff removed the CCTV setup from their building without notifying RVBC resulting in a very lengthy process to have that reinstated, and even then, it has had to be housed outside the police station.

RVBC are more than happy to accommodate any request from the police for a feed but at the moment we have not been asked.

- b. Agree that members assess whether the current RVBC cameras are fit for purpose.
- c. Reject the use of signage indicating CCTV is in use.
